MOROCCO DETAILED ITINERARY

09 Nov 2024 Arrive in Merzouga, MOROCCO

Welcome to Merzouga. Merzouga is a small Moroccan town in the Sahara Desert, near the Algerian border. It's known as a gateway to Erg Chebbi, a huge expanse of sand dunes north of town. West of Merzouga, Dayet Srji is a seasonal salt lake that's often dry in summer. When full, it attracts a wide range of migratory and desert birds, including desert warblers, Egyptian nightjars and, occasionally, flamingos

Round trip with guided visit to Kasbah Ait Ben Haddou and Ouarzazate from Kasbah Hnini. The Kasbah of Ait Ben Haddou, A fortress of sand, Breathtakingly beautiful, the Kasbah is a stunning work of architecture overlooking the Ounila Valley, Listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO, this group of adobe kasbahs is one of the oldest and most impressive ksars in all Morocco. The construction of the first building, an attic on the top of the hill, dates back to the 11th century. Village gradually grew up around it over the course of the centuries, adding houses, more granaries, cowsheds, a well, and protective surrounding walls. Immortalized in films such as "Lawrence of Arabia", "Babel" or "Indiana Jones", this fortress untouched by time stands like a rough diamond emerging from the surrounding rock face. Then visit Ouarzazate, With its magnificent landscapes, exceptional light and ideal climate conditions, Ouarzazate have always seduced filmmakers to the region.



The town now contains three large studios. The Atlas Studios were set up in 1983, are open to the public, and are certainly well worth going out of your way to see. Behind their doors, guarded by gigantic pharaohs, you can wander through a host of amazing sets, peek into the workshops where they are created, and get a real idea of what goes on behind the scenes in the movie industry.
